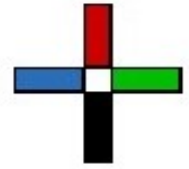

SEA SUNDAY COLLECTION FOR STELLA MARIS (APOSTLESHIP OF THE SEA) - Sunday 13th July

95% of all our goods are delivered to us by ship. Unfortunately, the seafarers that work on these vessels are mainly from developing countries as their labour is cheap. They work long hours and have long contracts of 9 to 12 months. Their salary is sent back to their families.

Stella Maris (Star of the Sea) has chaplains and volunteer ship visitors in each port (including Teignmouth) around the country and internationally, which allows us to care for the seafarers spiritually, practically, and emotionally. Sea Sunday is an important day in our calendar allowing us to share the work of our ministry and raise funds for the charity. Thank you for your generosity and your prayers.

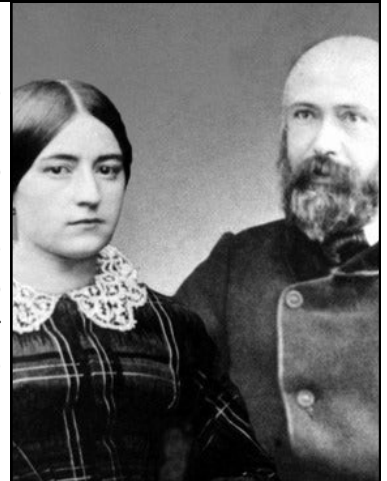

SAINTS OF THE WEEK

SAINTS LOUIS MARTIN (1823-94) & AZÉLIE-MARIE GUERIN (1831-77)

Louis Martin was a watchmaker from Bordeaux who had wanted to join the Augustinians but was refused because he showed no aptitude for Latin. Azélie-Marie Guerin was a lacemaker from Gandelain who had wanted to become a nun but was refused because of her respiratory weakness. So, instead she prayed that God would give her children who would consecrate themselves to Him. Louis and Zélie met and fell in love. Zélie was so successful in her lacemaking that Louis gave up watchmaking and joined her in business. They were both very devout and loving parents, having nine children, although only five daughters survived childhood, all of whom became nuns, including their youngest, St Thérèse. **Fest day: 12th July**
