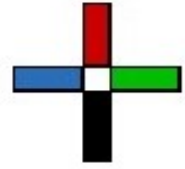

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST COLUMBA (521-9th June 597 A.D.)

Columba (or Colmcille in his native Irish) was born of Irish Christian nobility in County Donegal, Ireland. Due to the efforts of Romano-British missionaries like St Patrick, Christianity still existed in the British Isles among the Welsh, Cornish, and Irish, before the mission of St Augustine, with great centres of culture and learning in the monasteries. Columba grew up in this Celtic Christian network, and grew in learning. He became a monk and a priest, and began establishing more monasteries in Ulster. In 563, Columba and some companions travelled to Scotland, to the Kingdom of Dál Riata (modern Argyll). There he established the monastery on Iona which became a hub of missionary activity, especially to the Picts near Inverness and Aberdeenshire. Eventually Iona would send missionaries to the northern Anglo-Saxon kingdoms too. Columba spread the gospel through his hymns, sermons, and personal witness. Tradition states that he died in Iona on 9th June 597
