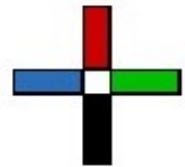

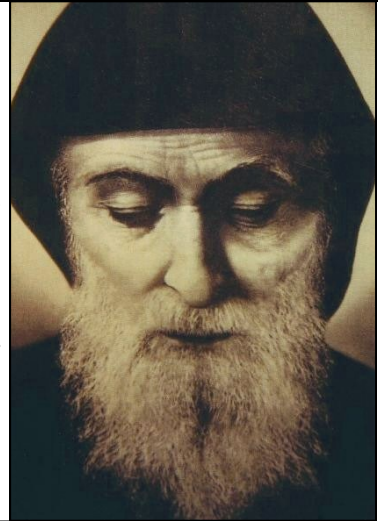
STOP ASSISTED SUICIDE BEING LEGALISED

SAINT OF THE WEEK

ST CHARBEL MAKHLOUF (1828–24th December 1898 A.D.)

Youssef Antoun Makhlof was born in Bekaa Kafra, in what is now Lebanon, but then part of the Ottoman Empire. His family were Maronite Catholics. His father died when he was three and his mother then married a man who became the local priest. Youssef grew up very devout with a deep interest in prayer, creating a shrine to Our Lady in the field where he would look after the family's cows. In 1851, aged 22, he joined a monastery, receiving the name Charbel. On July 23rd 1859, he was ordained a priest. He lived the life of hermit, devoting himself to ascetism and prayer especially before the Holy Eucharist. Charbel became known as a powerful intercessor. In December 1898 he suffered a stroke while celebrating Mass and died on 24th December. However, a few months after his death, a bright light was seen around his tomb and his body was discovered to be incorrupt. People continued to ask for his intercession and he became known as the 'Miracle Monk of Lebanon.'
